“Academic scholarships for freshmen at Whitworth still have very specific GPA and SAT requirements that must be met in the admissions process: The Mind and Heart scholarship requires a 3.75 GPA from high school and a minimum 2020 SAT

The Presidential scholarship requires a 3.75 GPA from high school and a minimum 1870 SAT

The Trustee scholarship requires a 3.60 GPA from high school and a minimum 1800 SAT

The Legacy scholarship requires a 3.5 GPA from high school and a minimum 1720 SAT

The policy revision involves the Whitworth GPA required of a student (who comes in with one of the above scholarships) in order to maintain the scholarship once he/she is enrolled at Whitworth. We revised the Whitworth GPA necessary to maintain these academic scholarships to match the GPA required at Whitworth (see Whitworth catalog) to maintain satisfactory academic progress (2.0 gpa) and to graduate (2.0 gpa). Since approximately 87% of incoming freshmen receive one of the above academic scholarships we thought it best to bring the GPA requirement in line with the GPA requirement for satisfactory academic progress and for graduation.
