CAMPUS PARKING

Whereas: Parking is one of the most reoccurring student complaints.

Whereas: Within a three-year period, more than 100 resident-living environments were added to the campus population.

Whereas: Within the same three-year period more than 20 parking spaces were removed to make room for more academic space.

Whereas: The on-campus population continues to grow.

Whereas: Students have paid for the right to park on campus.

Whereas: Events are held on campus, taking numerous spaces from students who have paid for parking permits.

Whereas: The Faith In the Future Campaign did not include plans for more parking.

Be It Resolved That:

1. On behalf of the students, ASWC demands that a plan for fixing the parking problem be presented in writing and through a presentation to the ASWC Assembly within the month of February.
2. A \$5 refund will be given to the students having a parking permit if point 1 is not met.
3. No students may be fined for illegal parking on days that the college hosts any events that take parking from students, until the proposal for parking is approved by the ASWC Assembly.
